PSOJ JMMB ANNUAL ECONOMIC FORUM (AEF) 2009:

The forum will be held under the theme: “*The Crisis Is Too Good an Opportunity to Waste: Smart Choices for Our Economy*” this year. It will explore the real impact of local and international environment on the Jamaica economy and practical implications for medium-term growth. “Out of this partnership with PSOJ we seek to address the key imperatives which we need to action to move forward in a real way through partnership and collaboration,” stated Duncan in commenting on the overall objective of the forum.
